Going Deeper In the Mass – Christians have a tendency today to be overly critical of their "preacher's sermon." Catholics call it the "homily." What has compounded their hypercriticism is that they have online access to the greatest speakers in the world with the click of a button and can unreasonably expect their own pastor, deacon, priest, bishop, etc. to "hit a home run" each time and to speak to their own individual needs. Such a mentality, betrays an egocentrism that forgets that the homily isn't just for "me" each week. We should regularly pray that the Word of God proclaimed and preached touches those in most need of the Lord's mercy, love, and tenderness. *If all you get is one nugget from a homily, then praise God!* Yes, the preacher should diligently prepare by study and prayer. But the listener should as well! *How often do you come to Mass without even having read the Sunday readings yet?* Without having read the readings, distractions outside of your control are bound to prevent you from entering into the Word of God and finding that one nugget you need. Going forward as a community, we will attach a weekly link to a reflection by Bishop Daniel Mueggenborg's on the Sunday Readings. Each provides deep insights and questions to help you find that nugget you need for the week.
