## Thursday, May 20<sup>th</sup> is the 31<sup>st</sup> Anniversary of Pier Giorgio's Beatification

Take a few moments on this day to thank God for the Blessed life of Frassati. His castles still stand, his river still flows, his poor are still with us, and he is watching over us. May the simplicity of his spirituality sustain you in difficult moments and bring you safely one day to heavenly shores.

Oh, Risen Jesus, the poor recognized You in Pier Giorgio because You gave him the grace to recognize You in them. Illuminate our hearts so that, like him, we can recognize You in the people around us, especially those in need of our help. Amen. *(from the Via Lucis)*

Meaningful ways to remember Blessed Frassati during the month of his beatification:

1. Serve the poor in a way that costs you something. Give yourself to them in a way that invites you out of your comfort zone.
2. Spend some intentional prayer time on or near water. Remember Pier Giorgio's love for the outdoors and how he encountered his Creator there.
3. Pray for Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati's canonization. Ask his heavenly buddy, Pope Saint John Paul II (who loved and beatified him) to pray for this special intention!
