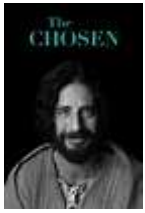
Although Seton School is not a church, it is our worship space. Upon entering the building, we ask that you maintain a spirit of silence, reverence, and prayerfulness to prepare yourself for Mass and for the sake of others. Jesus is present in the tabernacle in the room behind the altar, if you would like to pay Him a visit before Mass begins.

Reminder there are opportunities to attend "daily" Mass at Seton on Thursday (7:00 pm) and Saturday (8:30 am).

Faith Formation, First Communion, and Confirmation — Our faith formation program is a family-based program that meets weekly on Sundays. It's a time for families — parents, grandparents, and children — to come together to learn about and share their faith. We hope the conversation that begins on Sunday morning continues throughout the week in the car and around dinner tables and that parents and their children will grow in the knowledge and love of Christ. Our Sunday morning Family Faith Formation is the hub of all our religious education. The First Communion/Reconciliation and Confirmation workshops flow out of our Sunday morning Family Faith Formation program; these workshops will begin in October and meet approximately once a month. We will meet at **Seton Catholic School**.
