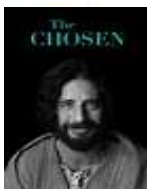

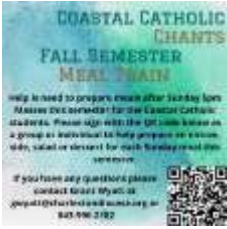


ADVENT WREATHS

Memorial of St. Pope John Paul II

Friends,

Over the past fourteen months, we've done such a wonderful job of welcoming people into CCCF that people regularly tell us that *welcoming* is a main reason for joining our growing yet intimate family. In reflecting upon this and the many initiatives that occur after Masses and throughout the week, I have begun conversations with various members of our community about how to better tailor the "exit" experience. How can we better *engage* people as they leave Mass or other events and *send* them out after having been fed on the Word of God and the Eucharist? With this in mind, we are beginning the following measures to advance the mission of our community – "Preparing disciples for the good adventure":

- Our newly formed Knights of Columbus council will be laying pavers at the main entranceway into Seton School to make it a larger and more intimate place to gather.
- We are creating a clearly marked Information Booth where you will be able to request and receive pertinent information and register for ministries, events, communications, etc.
- We are creating a Prayer Station, where anyone desiring specialized prayers for their needs or those of others can receive them, list them in our community's prayer book, and/or request for a Mass to be said.
- Family-Based Faith Formation will begin providing a weekly list of questions and/or activities that can be done during the week after family meals and/or the Lord's Day to further Sunday morning's discussion.
- We will implement a fundraising and "tabling" policy on November 1st that will require a form (found at the Information Booth or on our webpage) to be filled out and approved by Father David for those desiring to "set up shop" before and after Masses. The policy is not meant to discourage initiatives, but to make sure that each is effective and pertains to our mission. Fundraising efforts and "tabling" will be scheduled monthly to avoid excessive overlapping, duplications of events, and turning our "Father's House into a marketplace."

With all these measures, I would ask that you take to heart the words of Fr. James McKarns, "We may have our own agendas, but sometimes they must be set aside in order to follow a bigger plan with our service motto: thy will be done."
