Jesus is present in the tabernacle in the room behind the altar, if you would like to pay Him a visit before Mass begins.

Patronal Feast for the USA – We will celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception on December 8<sup>th</sup>. We will have a vigil Mass on December 7<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm and a Mass on December 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. Since 1846, our nation has been entrusted to Mary under this title by our US bishops. This is a Holy Day of Obligation and ranks as one of the highest feast days in the USA, second only to Sundays. O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to you!



#### From your music ministry team: Welcome to Advent!

Your choir has been busy with rehearsals in preparation for this wonderful season. Here is some information to help you 'prepare' for Christmas. The men of the choir will be singing Gregorian chant - a familiar piece "O Come O Come Emmanuel", but doing it in the original style - just men, a cappella (without the piano) and without harmony. Chant is the oldest sacred music and is unique to the Catholic tradition. The ladies of the

choir will be singing a carol whose text was written by Eleanor Farjeon from England - "People Look East". For this music the ladies will divide briefly into 3-part harmony.

Be on the lookout for this music at the Masses in December - choir sings on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.

We also invite you to a special music offering before the 7:00 pm Mass on Christmas Eve. Come sing familiar carols with the choir and enjoy solos, trios and special music friends from Conway that are on the program. Music will begin at 6:30, so please come early to find a seat and enjoy the music without interruption.
